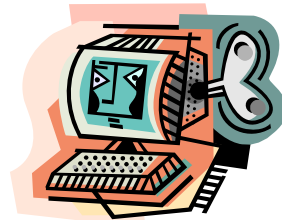

Goals

ChPCUG is a 501 (c) (3) charitable organization that has been active in Anne Arundel County since 1984. Computer users are assisted through education classes, monthly user meetings, a newsletter, and the opportunity to participate in Special Interest Groups (SIGs). ChPCUG collaborates with all organizations and government agencies interested in advancing computer knowledge for members of the local community.

Monthly Program Meetings

Monthly meetings consist of question and answer periods and a presentation related to the use of computer technology or computer software.

Newsletter

A newsletter, *The Printer*, consisting of announcements and articles of interest to the membership is published monthly September through June.

Special Interest Groups (SIG)

SIGs consist of small group discussions, demonstrations, and the opportunity to share area of interest.

Refurbishing SIG

Volunteers refurbish computers for those individuals, families, and nonprofit organizations unable to afford the purchase of a new computer. A modest donation is requested from those able to provide it. Grants allow provision of computers at no cost to those unable to make the donation.

The CRSIG meets during the day on most Wednesdays and Thursdays at the workshop. It is not necessary to be a member of ChPCUG to be a volunteer.

Donations of computer (2GHz min) and peripherals are welcome from individuals, organizations, businesses, and government agencies. Printers or scanners are not being accepted at this time. Written acknowledgements are provided (501[c] 3).

Refurbishing computers helps to conserve valuable resources and protects the environment.

Grants and cash donations are also needed to support this work. There is no paid staff and virtually all funds are used in support of the refurbishing process.
